Broadband in Blue Hill

Pre-Order for <u>Fidium Fiber</u> is available now! Fidium, a fiber based Internet service is

coming to The Blue Hill Peninsula from Fidium Fiber through the efforts and collaboration/communication between the Maine Connectivity Authority, Consolidated Communications Inc. (CCI) and local entities like Peninsula Utility for Broadband (The PUB) and Island Institute. The Peninsula – from Castine to

Stonington – is getting Fiber to the Home and Small Business for anyone that wants it. No more paying to connect because of your distance to the pole like some others do (i.e. Spectrum), and the cost of the symmetrical service (same upload/download "speeds") at up to 2,000 Megabits per second (Mbps) (aka 2 Gig), will be less than you are paying now for substantially less capability and service.

How is this being funded?

- 1. Funding awarded to CCI (owner of the Fidium brand) from the FCC,
- 2. Funding from the National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA) awarded to ConnectMaine with CCI as the provider and
- 3. Millions invested by CCI for the Peninsula.

Hamilton Marine Order Service located in the Ship's Store at KYC.

This is a service offered to all members.

How it works:

Place your order in the store before 3:00 pm and the item will arrive around 9:00 am the next business day, *as long as it is in stock*. All orders would need to be placed through the store. The store is located behind the clubhouse. Kelly is happy to do this via email (followed up by a call), phone, or in person. There is a Hamilton catalog in the store if needed.

The items do not cost the member more than what the parts are priced at in the catalog. There is no surcharge for the delivery from Hamilton, as they are giving the club a small discount for having one ordering location. It makes it easier for Hamilton as well as convenient for our Club.

The Hamilton order will be placed and once arrived, you can charge it to your account or pay by credit card, apple pay or google pay.
